



Webelo Woods Mountain Man Camp

General Information

Camp Check-In:

When: Saturday, October 22nd, 2011 - 7 AM (Starts)

Where: Camp Headquarters, Camp Trevor Rees-Jones Scout Camp,
Clements Scout Ranch

Procedures for Check-In:

Upon arrival at Camp Headquarters, a Pack representative needs to check-in for the unit and bring:

1. Copy of Pack Registration and payment verification (from registration system)
2. A list of scout cancellations, if applicable (for class roster adjustments)
3. Check for payment (made out to Circle 10)
4. BSA Medical (Parts A&B) on all youth and adult attendees (You'll keep these throughout the day).
5. YPT Certificate – for all Adult Leaders present (go to myscouting.org to take YPT or print out your certification).

You'll receive:

1. Camp site assignment and map
2. Class Rotation Schedule
3. One (1) Vehicle Pass

Safety:

As Unit Leader, you are responsible for maintaining 2-Deep Leadership throughout the event for YOUR scouts. If scouts are horseback riding, WW staff will provide that leadership while adults stay behind at the lower corral.

- **VEHICLES:** No vehicles are allowed stay at your campsite. As a courtesy, one vehicle pass will be issued at HQ to each unit at Check-In. ONE VEHICLE may drop off your camping gear at your assigned campsite. Please return your vehicle to the parking lot as soon as possible. Same with camp tear down on Sunday. We ask that you comply with these rules for the safety of everyone by sharing the pass with the other drivers in your unit.

- Additional parking passes may be issued to adults with physical disabilities or medical condition (should have a handicapped placard).
- Parking will be located across the road from headquarters.

Camp Setup

Campsite setup is to take place during lunch break on Saturday. However, if you have additional adults that wish to do this earlier, ok. Just make sure you meet your 2-Deep Leadership requirements for your scouts as they go to their classes through out the day.

You'll be camping with an experienced Boy Scout Troop. Let those youth assist your Webelos in camp setup and tear-down. Again, this is the time to let the boys do the work, with the guidance of the older scouts.

Check Out

Begins at 9am Sunday morning. Send your unit representative to HQ to request a site inspection and to complete an evaluation. After your campsite is reviewed and signed off; you may depart. Remember, only one vehicle at camp at a time. Have a safe drive back to Dallas.
