What will we do? Boys will participate in activities designed to build their fitness, character and understanding of US citizenship. All activities are fun and hands on so that the boys remain excited.

As a Cub Scout, your son will have the opportunity to go camping, attend sporting events, learn about nature, learn how to care for the US flag, develop an understanding of social responsibility and to build his leadership and communication skills.

When will we have our meetings? Most groups meet a couple times a month and go on outings every other month.

Do I have to attend with my son? Most parents enjoy the activities that Scouts participate in. Parents play an important role in the development of the boys. However, most parents have busy schedules and work with other parents to provide supervision and leadership.

Where are the meetings?: Meetings are held in neighborhood schools.

How much does it cost? Compared to most activities, Scouting is relatively cheap. Scouts pay for their activities as they go. Registration fee is \$10.00. Each Cub Scout group, or Pack, is responsible for setting their own dues. Uniforms can be bought new or purchased from other parents as their sons grow out of them

What if my son is playing sports? Most boys involved in Scouting are involved in other activities such as sports, band, etc. Scouting accommodates children with busy schedules.
