As a leader, the first thing for you to do is to make a campsite reservation for your unit. Email your reservation request to [kip@kipmotor.com](mailto:kip@kipmotor.com) and provide the following information; unit number, leader name, mailing address, phone # & email address and the approximate number of campers expected.

Participants may register for this event on-line from the website. You will need to know unit number and shirt size for each person. Adults will also need to know the date on their YPT (Youth Protection Training) card.

Special notes;

- On-line registration will be available beginning 8/17.
- Only those registering on-line by 9/20 are guaranteed an event T-shirt (uniform of the day)
- To reserve a campsite for your unit, you must make your reservation by 9/30.
- Only staffing units will be allowed to camp on Friday night.
- A C-ration lunch will be provided on Saturday.
