TO: Cub Scout Parents

WHAT: North Trail District Twilight Camp is an annual weeklong Cub Scout Camp held during the evening in the summer. It is five full evenings of activities such as Archery, BB guns, Sports, and Scout Skills that are not only fun, but also educational and informative.

This year's theme is "*Cubs on the Range*" – a weeklong adventure into the Wild West. Your cub scout will learn new skills and have fun while learning about life as a cub scout-aged boy during the pioneer days.

Webelos also have the opportunity to participate in an overnight campout at the park on Friday night with the Boy Scouts for an additional \$5 fee. This overnight will begin after the camp ends on Friday night. They are required to attend the campout with an adult. More information on the campout will be available at <http://www.northtrail.org> and will be distributed during camp and Walking Den Leader training.

WHO: Twilight Camp is open to all registered Cub Scouts entering the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, or 5th grades as of September 1, 2007. Boys who are entering the 6th grade cannot attend Cub Scout Camp, but are instead, encouraged to attend a Boy Scout Camp.

DATE: June 11-15, 2007 for Bears, Wolves and Webelos
June 13-15, 2007 for Tigers

TIME: 4:00 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.
Note: Please arrive by 3:30 p.m. Monday for check-in. On Friday night there will be a special family picnic as well as our traditional Webelos overnight campout.

WHERE: Breckinridge Park, 3300 Brand Rd., Richardson

WEAR: Camp T-shirt, shorts or pants, tennis shoes or hiking boots (NO open toed shoes of any kind), socks, bug spray, sunscreen.

FEES: \$20.00 for Tigers (boys entering first grade), \$45.00 (Bears/Wolves/Webelos) before June 1, 2007. There is an additional \$5 fee for Webelos who wish to attend the Friday night campout. Only **completed** registrations will be accepted. All others will be returned for completion. Fee includes one t-shirt, water bottle and a patch. Please make checks payable to BSA, Circle Ten.

REGISTER: Submit the required registration forms to your Pack's Twilight Camp Coordinator. If your pack or den is not attending, you may register as an individual by mailing the required forms to the home of Theresa Dolan (Address is listed below). This packet includes all forms needed to register your cub scout. Registration forms are available on the web at <http://www.northtrail.org>

ACHIEVEMENTS: Each evening is filled with fun activities that are age appropriate, and are built around advancements for each level (Tiger Cub, Wolf, Bear & Webelos). There will be plenty of opportunities for your son to earn credits toward achievements, electives, and belt loops. After camp is over, your Cub Master will receive a report showing achievements completed at each activity area.

Note: It is the responsibility of your Pack to provide belt loops and other rank items earned while at camp.

MEDICATION AT CAMP: If a camper is bringing medication to camp, it should be in the original container and have the camper's name and specific dosage instructions. The Adult Volunteer in your assigned den will collect any such medications and turn them in to the Camp medical officer. Asthma inhalers and Epi-pens may remain with the camper.

VOLUNTEERS: All volunteers (Staff, Adult Volunteers, JR Staff) must wear current camp t-shirt while at camp, attend a camp training session, and be trained in Youth Protection policies. For security reasons, persons not wearing a camp t-shirt will be escorted to headquarters to register their attendance.

TIGER CUBS (cubs entering 1st grade in 9/2007): Must be accompanied by their Adult Partner who is their parent, legal guardian, or a trusted adult and is the adult listed on the registration form). Their Adult Partner is considered an Adult volunteer and must be registered and attend a camp training session.

REGISTRATION: Please register only one person per form using the proper registration sheet (Cub or Adult Volunteer). Registration should be done through your pack. However, you may register without the pack (if you are doing so, please contact the Registrar). All required registration forms, FAQs, and other information are available on the Web at <http://www.northtrail.org>

MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS: Texas State Day Camp and BSA regulations require that every person (adults & children) attending camp must complete a registration form and a Medical Release Form with actual immunization dates (month and year) and have it on file with the camp medical officer. Any registrations turned in without immunization dates on medical form will be returned as an incomplete registration.

PARKING: All cars must park in the parking lot at entrance B and take the shuttle bus to entrance C. Only vehicles with handicapped plates or tags will be allowed to park at entrance C.

TRANSPORTATION: Parking is very limited, so car-pooling with others in your Pack is strongly suggested.

Parents who are not picking-up their own boys will need to furnish a note to their Volunteer Den Leader identifying who will be responsible for picking-up their son each night.

Sign-in/Sign-out Procedure: Scouts must be signed in with walking den leader upon arrival. Likewise, scouts must also be signed out with walking den leader before departing. Late arrivals and visitors must sign in with the registrar. Visitors will be clearly identified at all times by a visitor band. Early departures must also check in with the registrar before departing.

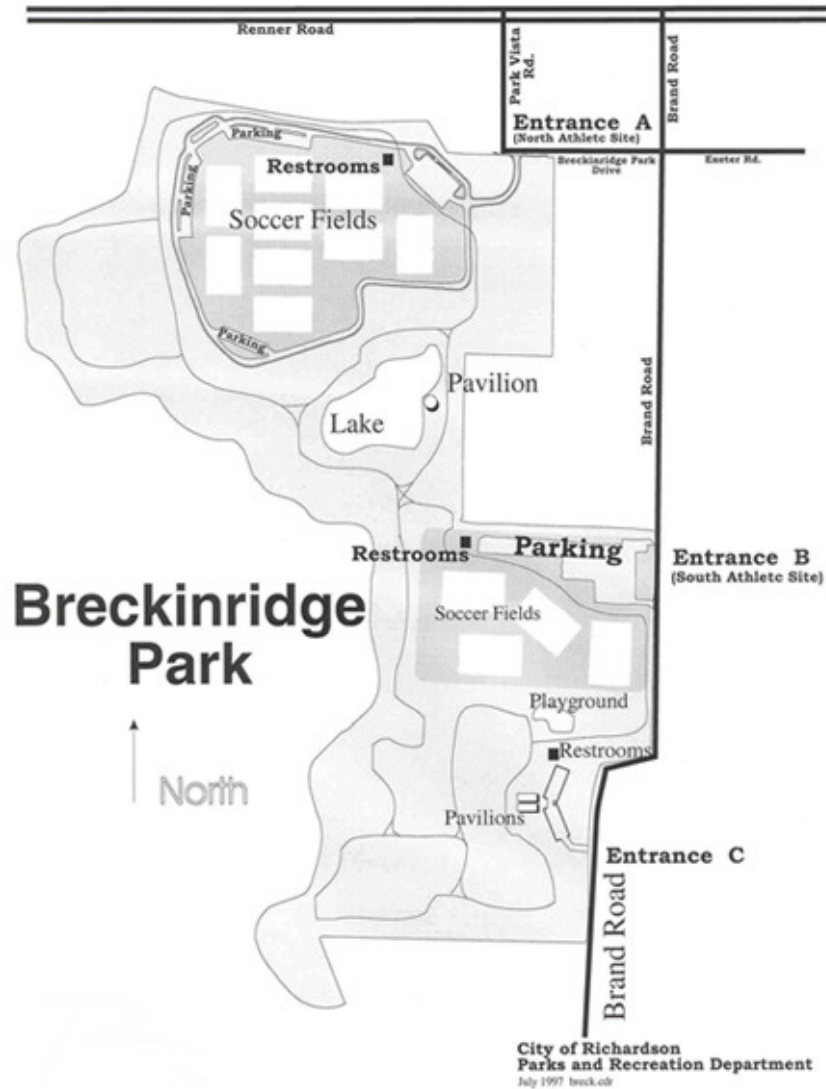

WHAT DO I GET FOR MY MONEY ?

Your Cub Scout will receive a sharp-looking camp t-shirt, a camp patch, water bottle and activity supplies. He will meet a lot of other boys and have fun and should earn some belt loops. (His pack will be responsible for getting you those awards.).

HOW DO I REGISTER ?

To register for Twilight Camp, complete the appropriate forms for every person attending and turn them in, along with the appropriate fees, to your Unit leader (Cub Master, Den Leader) or your Twilight Camp Coordinator.

CAN I HELP ?

Parent participation is strongly encouraged and welcomed. If parents would like to participate, please complete all the required forms for an "Adult Volunteer". To be an Adult Volunteer you must complete the registration form, attend one of the Twilight Camp training courses, agree to the terms and conditions on the Volunteer registration form, and submit the appropriate fee. Please retain a copy of any training, CPR or Youth Protection cards submitted with your form.

MY SON IS NOT A CUB SCOUT. CAN HE STILL ATTEND ?

Yes! Simply fill out a BSA Cub Scout application and submit it with all the other Twilight Camp forms. To acquire a Cub Scout application, call Jeff Molepske (see number below). This form may be submitted with your registration form.

MY SON JUST COMPLETED KINDERGARTEN. CAN HE ATTEND ?

Yes! If he is not already a "Tiger Cub" in a local Cub Scout pack, simply fill out a BSA Cub Scout application and submit it with all the other Twilight camp forms. BSA policy requires that an Adult Partner (Parent/Guardian) accompany each Tiger Cub during scout events. Also, Texas State Camp regulations require that every adult participating/volunteering at camp be a registered & trained volunteer. So, Tiger Cub Adult Partners must be registered and trained Twilight camp Adult Volunteers.
