

SPRING RECRUITMENT!!!

TIGER CUB TUESDAYS

Welcome to our four step process for Spring Time recruitment

- 1.) North Trail will pass out recruitment flyers schools promoting Twilight Camp
 - These flyers will be going out to each elementary school. They invite kids to join Cub Scouts and attend Twilight Camp.
- 2.) Organize a Spring recruitment event at your school!
 - Every unit should have some form of spring recruitment. The recruitment event should target incoming 1st graders at a minimum. We want these kids to get a head start on Tiger Cubs and attend Twilight camp. It is better to recruit them now than compete for their time in the fall.
 - Beyond Tiger cubs, we recommend you target recruiting for all cub ranks. We want to take every opportunity to build our Cub Packs. If you need help let Ron, Jeff, or Tony know.
- 3.) Bring a buddy program (BEST WAY TO RECRUIT KIDS)
 - The easiest way to recruit is to invite your cubs to bring a friend to join Cub Scouts (or Boy Scouts). Get them signed up and on your roster. Take a friend to the Scout Show THIS weekend! It is an excellent way to introduce them to scouting.
 - We do have an incentive program to reward your efforts. More below...
- 4.) WRING OUT- email a copy of your unit's roster to RFrederi@BSAmail.org
 - We are conducting a Spring Wring Out – We currently have an extraordinary shortfall in our active scout numbers. The wring out is designed to true up our numbers as we have completed the re-charter process. We need an accurate roster of all your scouts to compare to the system to ensure everyone is accounted for. This is especially true in regards to new Boy Scouts who have transitioned from Cubs during the re-charter time. The wring out covers both Cubs and Boys scouts; all units need to complete the roster and forward to Ron Frederich at RFrederi@BSAmail.org.

- We know there are new scouts out there from those recruitment events that have already taken place. We need all applications turned in as soon as possible. All units can turn in applications at the Cub Scout Roundtable on Thursday May 8th or at the Boy Scout Roundtable on Tuesday, May 13th. You can also turn them in at the Scout Office before 5/27/08.
